

**TOWNSHIP OF ALPINE

ORDINANCE NO. 13-07**

**AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING PAYMENT OF ALL AMOUNTS DUE THE TOWNSHIP
UPON REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF PLANS, PERMITS, CONTRACT
OR SIMILAR MATTERS**

THE TOWNSHIP OF ALPINE ORDAINS:

The Township shall not review or act on a request for the approval of plans, permits, contracts or similar matters if the applicant is in default of real or personal property taxes due to the Township or if the applicant is otherwise financially indebted to the Township. Pending appeals filed in good faith in a court or tribunal of competent jurisdiction shall not prohibit the Township from acting as requested, nor shall amounts deferred as authorized by law.

This ordinance shall become effective seven days after publication of a summary of its provisions in a local newspaper of general circulation in the Township.


