V. Millage Resolution for 2021-2022	

WHEREAS, The Township of Boyne Valley, County of Charlevoix, State of Michigan, has met all the requirements of Section 16 of the Uniform Budgeting and Accounting Act, allowing the levy of the maximum allowable millage greater than the Base Tax Rate to support the 2021-2022 fiscal budget as stated at a public hearing on the proposed budget held on March 22, 2021 at 7:33 pm at the Boyne Valley Township Hall, and

WHEREAS, Boyne Valley Township has complete authority to establish the number of mills to be levied from within its authorized millage rate of 2.12 mills total (1 mill Township allocated, .5 mill voted fire protection, .5 mill voted ambulance, .12 mill transfer station) allowed under "Headlee", and

WHEREAS, it is a requirement that an increase resolution be adopted by the Boyne Valley Township Board,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that Boyne Valley Township, County of Charlevoix, State of Michigan, levy 2.12 mills to support the 2021-2022 fiscal budget.
