IV. Board Update	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Jervis Webb Property Easement Tim explained why Jervis Webb is asking for the easement for the entry to the rear of the property. They are putting in a left turn lane and a right turn lane off M75 to the property as required by MDOT. It would be costly to extend these lanes to allow for truck traffic. MDOT will not allow trucks to use the same lanes. <p>Jervis Webb is willing to do whatever the township would like them to do to make the trail safe, ie. Lighting, signage, pavement striping. 2 to 4 trucks per day will use the entrance, which could increase to 5 to 6 per day.</p> <p>Russ Koeman spoke regarding the township concerns of afton stone being used for the temporary reroute.</p> <p>Tim agrees that some sort of hard surface could be used for the temporary re-route of the trail.</p> <p>Motion by Kondrat, support by Sparks to approve the easement presented as long as Jervis Webb will pay the township attorney fees up to \$7500, signage and lights to mark the entrance and to use a hard surface for the temporary trail and to wait to tear the trail up until DNR approval. Motion carried 5 to 0.</p>
