C TRAN is Chemung County's public transit system, with 12 accessible bus routes that can take you to popular destinations throughout the county. See the reverse for tips on how to ride C TRAN.

GOING SOMEWHERE FAR?

C TRAN has daily commuter routes that can take you to Corning, Ithaca, Owego, Sayre, and Waverly, where you can connect to other transit systems.

Intercity buses stop at the Chemung County Transportation Center in downtown Elmira on their way to Binghamton, Rochester, Buffalo, Albany, NYC, Harrisburg, Scranton, Philadelphia, and more.

ELM – Elmira Corning Regional Airport has several daily flights to various airport hubs. C TRAN's Elmira - Corning bus route stops right outside ELM.

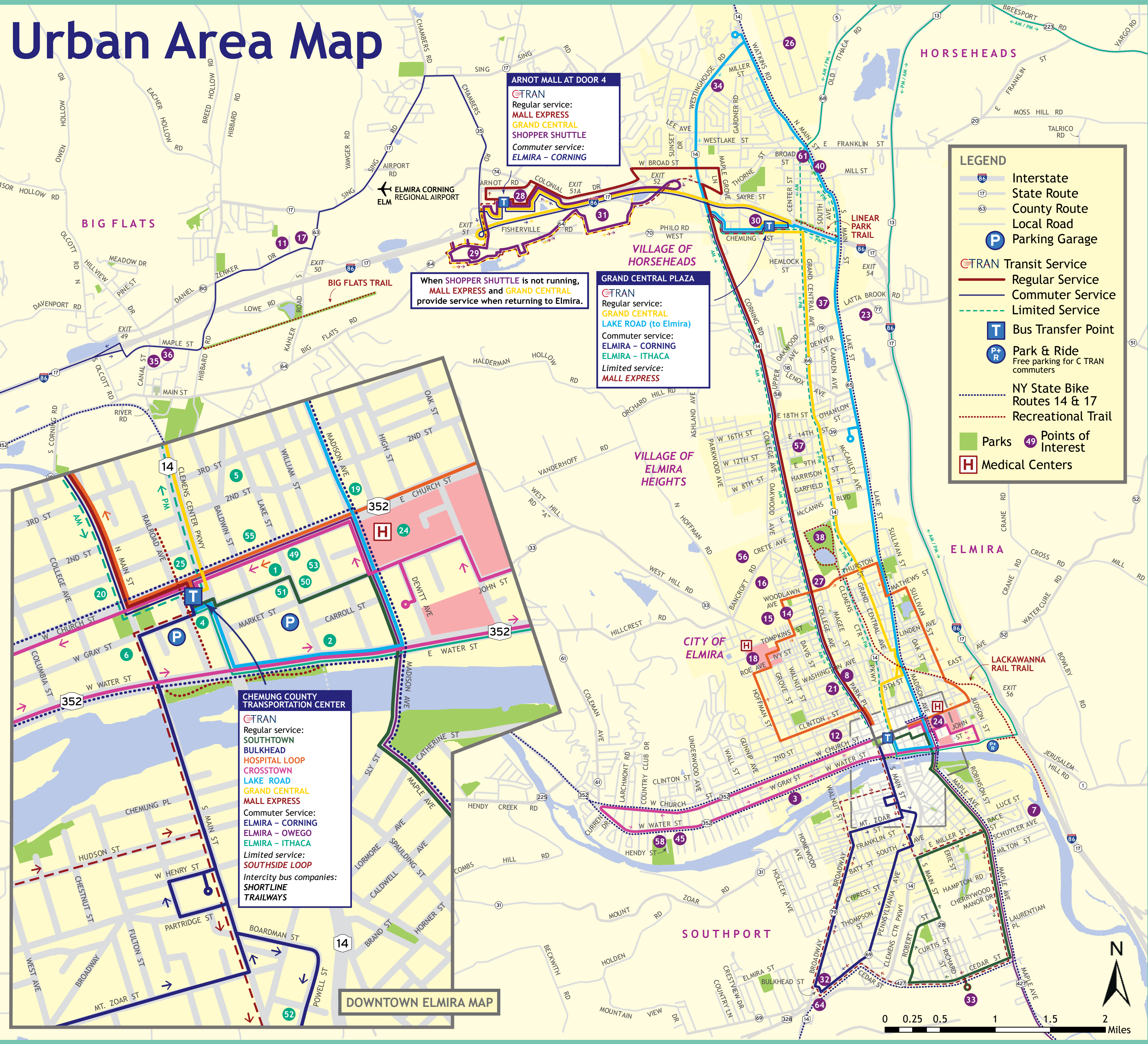

HOW TO RIDE ON C TRAN

1. Plan your trip

Use this map to determine the bus routes that will take you to your destination. Switch buses at transfer points, such as the Chemung County Transportation Center in downtown Elmira. Check the timing of the buses using the schedules provided at ridectran.com or at the Transportation Center. If you need trip planning help, call C TRAN at (607) 732-5211, Mon-Fri 7 AM to 7 PM & Sat 8 AM to 5 PM.

2. Wait for the bus and have fare ready

C TRAN buses can stop at all safe locations. A safe area to wait is the far side of an intersection. Wait by the curb at least 5 minutes before the bus is scheduled to arrive and flag the bus when you see it. While you wait, get your fare ready in exact change or a pass. Children up to five years old ride free. Half-fare is available for youth (6-18), seniors (60+), and people with disabilities (with a Half-Fare ID card). A list of fares can be found at ridectran.com/fares. Save money and time by purchasing tokens or passes at the Chemung County Transportation Center.

3. Board the bus and pay your fare

All buses are wheelchair-accessible. If you have any difficulty boarding the bus, ask the driver to lower the bus or activate the ramp. Insert your exact change in the farebox or show the driver your pass. Drivers do not make change. Find a place to sit and relax and enjoy the ride! Respect your fellow passengers and do not eat, drink, smoke, or play loud music on the bus.

4. Pull the cord when the bus is near your destination

When the bus is about one block away from your destination, pull the cord by the window so that the driver will know when to stop. Step off the bus when the bus stops. For questions about transit, call C TRAN at (607) 732-5211 or visit ridectran.com
