
House Bill 6 (Temporary Tax Waiver)

HB6 was introduced into legislation early June 2020 and passed on June 18, 2020. New Mexico Governor Michelle Lujan Grisham signed on June 29th, 2020 and HB6 went into effect.

All taxpayers in good standing that were late due to COVID 19 on their second half, that still have not paid after June 29th, 2020 will qualify for the HB6 program. Therefore, we can back date their penalties and interest back to May 10th and will not be charged.


Our Software company (TYLER) they created a program that identifies and flags all accounts that qualify. The way the program works is when a taxpayer contacts our office, we will pull up their account and a notification labeled (Cibola2019WaiverP&I), informs us that they qualify for HB6.

If a taxpayer is paying online and is having issues processing their payment, please contact our office. The reason being might be that the taxpayer has qualified for the program.

After receiving a payment by check or money order and an account qualifies for the HB6 program we will back date their payment to May 10th and apply their P/I to their account as prepayment for 2020 tax year.

The HB6 is a temporary bill. Bill expires May 2021. The program is only for the second half bill of 2019 when COVID 19 became in effect.
