Ellsworth, Kansas – It has been identified that there could be possible exposure of COVID-19 at the Ampride location in Ellsworth. If you were at Ampride on the following dates, please self-monitor for signs and symptoms.

Friday, October 2nd
Saturday, October 3rd
Sunday, October 4th
Monday, October 5th
Tuesday, October 6th

If you develop any of the symptoms listed below within 14 days from 10/6/2020, we strongly encourage you to contact the Ellsworth County Health Department or primary care provider. Testing for COVID-19 is currently available at Ellsworth County Health Department and Ellsworth County Medical Center. Please call prior to arriving to either facility.

- Fever of 100.4 F or higher
- Chills
- Rigors
- Myalgia (muscle pain or aches)
- Malaise
- Headache
- Sore throat
- Lower respiratory illness (cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing)
- New olfactory (smell) and taste disorders
- Nausea/vomiting
- Diarrhea

Ellsworth County Health Department thinks that it is important that the public be informed, monitor symptoms and contact primary caregiver or Ellsworth County Health Department if they become sick.
