MINUTES

February 16, 2021

The Board of Ellsworth County Commissioners convened this 16th day of February 2021 at the Ellsworth County Courthouse.

OPENING BUSINESS:

Chairman Dlabal called the meeting to order at 9:12 a.m.

Commissioner Bender moved to approve the Agenda. Commissioner Rolfs seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Dlabal moved to approve the Minutes for February 1, 2021. Commissioner Bender seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

No one was present for the open forum.

APPOINTMENTS:

Teresa Shute, Noxious Weed Supervisor, said she is hosting the Noxious Weed Director monthly meeting on the second Thursday of April for approximately 20 people.
