MINUTES

February 7, 2022

The Board of Ellsworth County Commissioners convened this 7th day of February 2022 at the Ellsworth County Courthouse. Dennis Rolfs was not in attendance.

OPENING BUSINESS:

Chairman Bender called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Commissioner Bender moved to approve the agenda. Commissioner Dlabal seconded the motion. Motion carried 2-0.

Commissioner Bender moved to approve the Minutes for January 31, 2022. Commissioner Bender seconded the motion. Motion carried 2-0.

APPOINTMENTS:

Shelly Vopat, County Clerk, informed the Commissioners that she would be using Postalocity to mail out her notices in June. SB13 makes County Clerks responsible for providing budget estimates beginning in 2022. The State of Kansas will be reimbursing Counties for 2022 and 2023, afterwards it is the responsibility of the County to pay for the cost of mailing out these estimates. Postalocity estimated the cost to be \$3,504.51. Commissioner Bender made a motion to go into executive session to discuss wages for non-elected personnel from 9:13 a.m. to 9:23 a.m. Commissioner Dlabal seconded the motion. Motion carried 2-0. At 9:23 a.m. the Commissioners returned to open session with no action taken.

The Commissioners reviewed the 2021 Inventory.

Commissioner Bender moved to approve resolution 2022R03, a resolution implementing the Ellsworth County burn ban. Commissioner Dlabal seconded the motion. Motion carried 2-0.
