MINUTES

January 3, 2022

The Board of Ellsworth County Commissioners convened this 3rd day of January 2022 at the Ellsworth County Courthouse.

OPENING BUSINESS:

Chairman Dlabal called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Commissioner Bender moved to approve the agenda with an addition of Nathan Florian. Commissioner Rolfs seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Rolfs moved to approve the Minutes for December 28, 2021. Commissioner Bender seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

No one was present for the open forum.

APPOINTMENTS:

Nathan Florian, EMS Director, requested permission to apply for an EIG grant, a grant from the State of Kansas that would pay for a class for a new EMT. Commissioner Bender moved to allow Nathan Florian to apply for the EIG grant for a new EMT. Commissioner Rolfs seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

OLD BUSINESS:

Commissioner Rolfs moved to approve Abatement 2021 #29 for \$57.08. Commissioner Bender seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

NEW BUSINESS:

Commissioner Bender moved to approve Abatement 2021 #30 for \$91.46 and an Add 2021 #31 for \$91.46. Commissioner Rolfs seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Rolfs moved to approve December accounts payable for \$248,783.62 plus prewritten warrants for \$48,269.43 for a total of \$297,053.05. Commissioner Bender seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Rolfs made a motion to rescind the burn ban, Resolution 2021R15. Commissioner Bender seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Rolfs moved to elect Greg Bender as Chairman and Dennis Rolfs as Vice-Chairman of the Ellsworth County Board of Commissioners for 2022. Commissioner Dlabal seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.
