January 4, 2021

The Board of Ellsworth County Commissioners convened this 4th day of January 2021 at the Ellsworth County Courthouse.

OPENING BUSINESS:

Chairman Dlabal called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Commissioner Rush moved to approve the Agenda with a change. Commissioner Rolfs seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Rush moved to approve the Minutes for December 28, 2020. Commissioner Dlabal seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Greg Bender was in attendance but did not wish to address the Commissioners.

APPOINTMENTS:

Stacie Schmidt, Ellsworth County Economic Development Director, asked Chairman Dlabal to sign papers for the CDBG grant because there were incorrect dates on the original paperwork that was signed last week.

Jeremiah Brown, EMS Director, presented the new Monitor/Defibrillator to the Commissioners.

Commissioner Rush moved to approve the December accounts payable for \$446,538.41 plus prewritten warrants for \$16,748.77 for a total of \$463,287.18. Commissioner Rolfs seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.
