

ELLSWORTH COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING

MINUTES

July 11, 2022

The Board of Ellsworth County Commissioners convened this 11th day of July 2022 at the Ellsworth County Courthouse.

OPENING BUSINESS:

Chairman Bender called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Commissioner Rolfs moved to approve the agenda. Commissioner Bender seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Bender moved to approve the Minutes of July 5, 2022. Commissioner Rolfs seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

No one was present for the public forum.

APPOINTMENTS:

Nathan Florian, EMS Director, asked if the County of Ellsworth was willing to pay the same amount the State of Kansas pays through the EIG grant for an employee who wants to take the paramedic class. The employee had previously started the class but was unable to complete the class at that time due to health issues and this makes her ineligible for the EIG grant. Commissioner Rolfs made a motion to allow Nathan Florian to use the education fund for \$5,110 with the stipulation that the employee signs the contract to work two years after passing the Paramedic class. Commissioner Dlabal seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0. Commissioner Rolfs made a motion to go into executive session with Nathan Florian to discuss non-elected personnel, specifically disciplinary, from 9:25 a.m. To 9:35 a.m. Commissioner Dlabal seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0. At 9:35 a.m. the Commissioners returned to open session with no action taken.

Jessica Kootz, representing Midway Extension District, informed the Commissioners that the fair was next week. Ms. Kootz provided each Commissioner with a fair book and asked if they had any questions.

OTHER BUSINESS:

Commissioner Rolfs moved to amend the motion from July 5, 2022, to pay Hall Construction \$18,840.25, less 10% until renovating the Clerk's Office is done. Commissioner Dlabal seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Rolfs moved to adjourn the meeting at 11:10 a.m. Commissioner Dlabal seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.
