AAR of Wilson fire Planning WCRC & Commendations	Community response to the needs of the residents of Wilson Care & Rehab Center were quite amazing. The community pitched-in together and assisted with all the transportation needs. Wilson Care & Rehab Center noted at the time of the incident, no evacuation plan was in place.	A plan will be augmented to meet the needs of the WCRC.		
Transportation:	Transportation for special needs population at the nursing home needs to be arranged prior to such an event. EMS noted that they should not be counted on for providing transportation as they are typically needed for emergency response.	WCRC will explore further possibilities when updating their evacuation plan.		
LEPC: After Action Review of the Wilson Fire	Emergency Manager informed us that no evacuation was actually needed of the City or of the Wilson Care & Rehab Center. Communication as to who ordered the evacuation is still unclear other than it came from Highway Patrol. Directions could have been provided to residents as to shutting off AC units or heating units, placing wet towels by door stops and window sills, etc.	Determine a better course of action to communicate with residents in any future events.
