

ELLSWORTH COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING

MINUTES

April 8, 2019

The Board of Ellsworth County Commissioners convened this 8th day of April 2019 at the Ellsworth County Courthouse.

OPENING BUSINESS:

Chairman Dlabal called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Commissioner Rush moved to approve the Agenda. Commissioner Rolfs seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Rolfs moved to approve the Minutes for April 1, 2019. Commissioner Rush seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

PUBLIC FORUM:

Anthony Hopkins, Kanopolis Mayor, inquired if the City of Kanopolis could have a waiver at the landfill because the City is going to demolish an abandoned house. Commissioner Rush made the motion to allow the City of Kanopolis a waiver for up to \$1500 for the demolition debris. Commissioner Dlabal seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Billy Kryger, Pastor of the Smoky Hill Baptist Church in Ellsworth, was in attendance but did not wish to address the Commissioners.

APPOINTMENTS:

Jeremiah Brown, EMS Director, invited the Commissioners to stop by and see the Stryker power lift system, now that it is installed in the ambulance. Mr. Brown asked if he could use \$4,000 from the County building fund to build the training room EMS wants. He has already secured \$10,000. Oneok Gas Company is contributing \$6,000 and the windfarm is contributing \$4,000. Commissioner Rolfs and Commissioner Rush seemed agreeable, although no motion was made. Mr. Brown presented his 2020 budget request for \$526,000 an increase of \$13,055 or 2.13%.

Emil Halfhill, Ellsworth City Chief of Police, thanked Sheriff Marston for implementing the Interpol Record Management system.

NEW BUSINESS:

Commissioner Rolfs moved to approve Abatement 2018-81 in the amount of \$221.92.
Commissioner Rush seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Rush moved to proclaim the month of April as Sexual Awareness Month.
Commissioner Rolfs seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.
