

**CITY OF FLEMINGSBURG
REGULAR MEETING OF BOARD OF CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
MONDAY, JUNE 13, 2022**

Mayor Robert Money called to order the regular meeting of the Board of City Council to order at 6:01 pm.

Councilman Danny Carpenter led all in the Pledge of Allegiance.

City Clerk, Crissy Cunningham called roll.

Motion to approve the regular meeting minutes from May 9, 2022, passed with a motion by Councilman Hurst and a second by Councilman Harmon. Motion passed with a unanimous vote in favor.

Mr. Mark Leet and Ms. Melissa Plank were present to propose a Hillsboro and Ward Elementary Fall Festival at the city park and reservoir. They plan to have vending, possibly a fishing tournament, movie in the park, and a trunk or treat. It was decided to plan for October 22, 2022.

Ms. Crystal Ruark was present to report for the Flemingsburg-Fleming County Chamber of Commerce. Ruark provided copies of the most recent newsletter. May events were discussed including small business May, 606 Sales Rodeo, and planning for Ewing Fest. The Cruising for Kids event was a huge success and the next one is planned for April 22, 2023. Upcoming June events include a ribbon cutting at Stockton Graveyard, Business Over Breakfast, Joe's Rod Run and the Summer Palooza. July events include 4th Festivities at the Rec Park, Chamber golf scramble and BBQ Festival.

Motion to approve 1st reading of an ordinance adopting the City of Flemingsburg, Kentucky General Fund Annual Budget for 7/1/2022 through 6/30/2023 passed with a motion by Councilman Harmon and second by Councilman Hurst. Motion passed with a unanimous vote in favor.

Motion to approve 1st reading of an ordinance adopting the Flemingsburg Utility Systems Budget for 7/1/2022 through 6/30/2023 passed with a motion by Councilwoman Graham and a second by Councilman Harmon. Motion passed with a unanimous vote in favor.

Mr. Rob Conn was present to report for Code Enforcement. He has issued 3 special permits the past month. He also advised council of a planning commission meeting the next evening.

Mr. David Gray was present to report on FCA-TV. He had covered the Rod Run. There will be a perspective on the summer palooza and 'on the porches' will continue this summer.

Chief of Police, Brian Bowling was present to report on the Police Department. He advised that SROs will be required at every campus. He also discussed May events held in the community. He discussed the UK students working on their plan for the city. Chief advised the new radios over the internet are working very well; homelessness is also a growing concern.

Mr. Joe Dunaway was present to report on utilities and public works. Employees will have gas training all this week. There was no update on water and wastewater projects. The solar lighting will go up in the next month. The rod run was a huge success; next year it will be held at the high school since it has grown so much.

Councilman Carpenter complimented the Chamber breakfast and the Rodeo. He also requested a breakdown of the budget.


Councilman Alexander advised the water report was in the packets.

Councilman Hurst commented on the good crowd at the rod run.


There being no further city business, the meeting was properly adjourned at 6:54 pm.
