MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF BOARD OF CITY COUNCIL
MONDAY, NOVEMBER 14, 2022, 6:00 PM

Mayor Robert Money called to order the November 14, 2022, regular meeting of the Board of City Council at 6:00 pm.

Councilman Danny Carpenter led all in the Pledge of Allegiance.

City Clerk, Crissy Cunningham, called for attendance.

Motion to approve the regular meeting minutes from the October 10th, 2022, meeting passed with a motion by Councilman Hurst and a second by Councilwoman Graham. Motion passed with a unanimous vote in favor.

Motion to accept the rebid for the Fleming County Senior Center project as will be advised from Buffalo Trace Area Development District passed with a motion by Councilman Harmon and a second by Councilman Hurst. Motion passed with a unanimous vote in favor.

Motion to provide a donation in the amount of \$2,500 for Eastern Kentucky Flood Relief via the Lions Club passed with a motion by Councilman Harmon and a second by Councilman Carpenter. Motion passed with a unanimous vote in favor.

Code Enforcement Officer, Mr. Rob Conn provided a written report in the council packets. There was discussion of placing liens on properties for mowing. The Planning and Zoning Board will have a public hearing and meeting on November 28th. Additional searchers and cadaver dogs have been in the area to help search for the missing person.

Mr. Dave Gray was present for FCA-TV. Gray advised he covered the political debate, the Lions Club Auction and is waiting to cover all the holiday events.

Chief of Police, Brian Bowling provided a written report in the council packets. Chief Bowling also recognized Officer Tim Smith for his advanced law enforcement certificate and congratulated Smith on his victory in the Fleming Co. Sheriff's election. Chief Bowling thanked the Fleming County Chamber of Commerce for the Community Service Award. Bowling discussed some staffing changes and being short-staffed.

Public Works Director Mr. Joe Dunaway provided a written report in the council packets. Dunaway reported 56 loads were hauled off during the Fall Clean-Up Week; the Spring Clean-Up is scheduled for

the last week in April. Dunaway reported some paving that needs to be done in the long-term. The snow equipment is ready for winter weather. Dunaway reminded for people to park on the correct side of their streets if they are on the snow route. Dunaway thanked the city for use of the distribution center for the Lions Club Radio Auction.

The Buildings and Grounds Committee met and discussed the rehab of the Princess Theater. There was discussion of contractors' suggestions including windows and doors. There was discussion of accessibility on the back side of the theater; work will all have to be done from the street side. There was further discussion of obstacles for this project. Motion to move forward with bids, etc. passed with a motion by Councilman Harmon and a second by Councilman Alexander. Motion passed with a unanimous vote in favor. Mayor Money advised some legal work is being done concerning the ownership of the Fried Building.

Councilman Carpenter inquired about the roof of the police department. Chief advised it is in the process of repairs.

Councilwoman Bolar thanked all the Council-elects for attending the meeting.

Councilwoman Graham asked for different financial reports showing what percentage is left on each budget line item. Graham discussed leasing a leaf truck during the fall to get rid of leaves. Mr. Joe Dunaway advised there has already been discussions of purchasing some type of equipment for this purpose.


Mayor Money recognized the new council-elects and thanked them for attending.

There being no further city business, the meeting was properly adjourned at 6:55 pm.
