We are requesting \$5,000 in assistance towards our cleanup efforts of the Atlantic Intracoastal Waterway, as well as other waterways within Nassau County. Keep Nassau Beautiful, Inc. (KNB) wishes to use this year's funding to greatly enhance our ongoing and future waterway cleanup efforts.

As you know, rivers, with tributaries that crisscross our interior, bound mainland Nassau County on three sides. Annually, we conduct the St Marys River Celebration (March 16, 2013), a one day volunteer event which focuses on the major waterways of Nassau County.

Please find enclosed a completed Small-Scale Derelict Vessel Removal Program Application submitted on behalf of the Miami-Dade County Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources' Division of Environmental Resources Management (DERM). DERM is applying for funding to be used for the removal and disposal of eight (8) derelict vessels currently sunk or grounded in Biscayne Bay in the vicinity of Watson Island. These vessels are all located within approximately one quarter to three-quarters of a mile east of the Intracoastal Waterway and all represent a real or potential hazard to navigation and to the environment.

DERM estimates that the contracted cost for the removal and disposal of these vessels will be \$26,000.00. We are requesting that FIND fund seventy-five percent of these costs (i.e. \$19,500.00). The remaining costs will be paid for by Miami-Dade County's Biscayne Bay Environmental Enhancement Trust Fund. Additionally, all costs related to management and oversight of the project will be born by Miami-Dade County.

Please note that in addition to the required Attachments A and B of the application, enclosed are FWC derelict vessel database reports and photographs of each of the eight derelict vessels to be removed, an aerial photo map showing the vessels' locations, and a contractor bid sheet. We respectively request that this application be considered at the next scheduled meeting of the FIND Commission.

### ATTACHMENT C Small-Scale Derelict Vessel Removal Projects Funding Policy (Rule 66B-2.015)

Proposals shall be accepted for financial assistance for the removal of derelict vessels within the District's waterways. The applicable provisions of this rule apply to these applications with the following additions or exceptions:

- (1) Application Procedure Applications shall be submitted on a completed FIND Form No. 05-01 (effective date 04-24-06), hereby incorporated by reference and available from the District office. Applications may be submitted to the District and considered by the Board at any time during the year.
- (2) The District shall only fund applicants that have identified derelict vessels to be removed and have an outstanding bid for removal for such vessels, subject to eligibility under these program rules.
- (3) The program must be sponsored by an eligible government agency or not-for profit organization.
- (4) District funding shall be limited to \$20,000 per county, per year, provided on a reimbursement basis only.
- (5) The eligible applicant must provide the remaining matching funds for project completion. In no case shall the District's cost-share contribution exceed 75% of the total project costs. In-house project management or administration costs are not eligible costs or matching costs.
- (6) The derelict vessel must be located in, the District's waterways, as defined in subsection 66B-2.003(28) "Waterways".
- (7) The District shall be recognized when possible in all written, audio or video advertising and promotions as a participating sponsor of the program.
- (8) The funding provided by the District shall only be allocated for removal of derelict vessels. The District is providing program reimbursement funds only and shall be held harmless with regards to the activities initiated by the applicant.
- (9) The applicant shall be responsible for all maintenance, management, disposal and operating expenses associated with the program.
- (10) Funds derived from the sale of any derelict vessels or vessel parts removed through this grant program must be reinvested into the applicant's derelict vessel removal program.
- (11) The District Board shall make all final decisions concerning the provision of funding for this program.




Biscayne Bay / Watson Island Derelict Vessel Removal Project – Vessel locations are within ¼ to ¾ mile from the ICW.







