I am happy to inform you that Miami-Dade County is already working on the celebration of the 30<sup>th</sup> annual Bayanza Biscayne Bay Cleanup Day. We have greatly appreciated the support for the Biscayne Bay Cleanup Day by the Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND) in past years, and look forward to working together again with FIND in 2012.

The 30<sup>th</sup> annual Biscayne Bay Cleanup Day is scheduled for **April 21<sup>th</sup>, 2012**, and is expected to draw over 7,000 community participants.
