RESOLUTION NO. 2014-02

RESOLUTION ADOPTING FINAL MILLAGE RATE OF TAXATION FOR THE PROPERTIES LYING WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE FLORIDA INLAND NAVIGATION DISTRICT FOR THE YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2014 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2015.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE FLORIDA INLAND NAVIGATION DISTRICT, THAT:

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners of Florida Inland Navigation District does hereby adopt as its final millage rate 0.0345 of a mill to be levied upon all of the real and tangible personal property located within the boundaries of the Florida Inland Navigation District (i.e. Nassau County, Martin County, Indian River County, Broward County, Volusia County, Duval County, St. Johns County, Flagler County, Brevard County, St. Lucie County, Palm Beach County and Miami-Dade County).

Section 2. This final millage rate of 0.0345 of a mill is to defray expenses of the Florida Inland Navigation District for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2014 and ending September 30, 2015.

Section 3. For purposes of Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, the "rolled-back rate" is 0.0323 of a mill. Thus, the millage rate established in Section 1 exceeds the "rolled-back rate" by 6.81%.
