Attached you will find additional information pertaining to Item #16 of the August 21, 2015 Board Agenda (mailed on Wednesday). The Evaluation Committee reviewing the Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for the Broward Intracoastal Waterway Deepening Project (Project), met at 11:00 AM on Thursday, August 13, 2015. The purpose of this Committee, comprised of: Tyler Chappell, Broward County FIND Commissioner; Mark Crosley, FIND; and John Adams, Taylor Engineering, was to evaluate and recommend to the full Board, a short-list of three (3) Respondents to provide bids for the Project.

The three (3) highest ranked Respondents, Great Lakes Dredge and Dock, Orion Marine Group and Cashman Dredging are recommended to the District Board of Commissioners to participate in the Invitation to Bid ("ITB") for the Project. Respondents have been advised that the Board of Commissioners is not bound by the Evaluation Committee's recommendation and the Board's final ranking may differ from the recommended list. Following the Board's action at the August meeting, all Respondents shall be notified by mail of the Board's final ranking.

In the event the Board decides to issue an Invitation to Bid ("ITB"), the Contract will be awarded to the qualified, responsible, and responsive Bidder presenting the lowest Bid. However, Respondents are advised that the Project is subject to an appropriation of funds by the District's Board of Commissioners. The Board reserves the right to reject any and all Respondents and future bids for this project, and nothing in this RFQ and/or the fact that the Board of Commissioners has approved the list of recommended Respondents shall obligate the Board of Commissioners or the District to proceed with the construction of the Project.

MEETING MINUTES BID QUALIFICATION CONTRACTOR SHORT-LIST August 13, 2015

A Public Meeting was held pursuant to Florida Statutes Section 255.0518 on August 13, 2015, 11:00 a.m. to rank contractors for the Broward Deepening Project. Mark Crosley, Executive Director of the District, called the meeting to order at 11:07 a.m. Those in attendance were Peter Martin with Orion Marine Group, Tom McSweeny with Great Lakes Dredge and Dock, Mark Crosley, Executive Director of FIND and Janet Zimmerman, Assistant Executive Director of FIND. Participating via phone were John Adams, Taylor Engineering and Tyler Chappell, FIND Commissioner for Broward County.

Mr. Crosley opened the meeting with the listing of the five (5) companies who have submitted bid qualification packages: Great Lakes Dredge and Dock, Ferreira Construction Co. Inc., Cashman Dredging, Weeks Marine Inc. and Orion Marine Group. These five (5) companies were evaluated by a committee of three (3), consisting of John Adams, Tyler Chappell, and Mark Crosley.

Mr. Crosley stated that the purpose of the meeting was for the committee to recommend the top three (3) ranked companies to the FIND Board at the August 21st Board meeting. The three (3) reviewers provided their individual scores which were then summed and averaged to provide an overall average total score for each company. Mr. Crosley read the top three (3) companies as: Orion Marine Group, Great Lakes Dredge and Dock and Cashman Dredging.

Mr. Chappell made a motion to recommend the top three (3) companies to the FIND Board. Motion seconded by Mr. Adams. No further discussion. Motion passes unanimously.

Mr. McSweeny asked if the access road to the DMMA site had been finalized. Mr. Crosley stated that it is still in the process of being formalized with FPL and should be finalized in a week or so.

Mr. McSweeny asked if contractors could have access to the site again prior to submitting a bid. Mr. Crosley state yes, and noted that the point of contact would be Mark Tamblyn, FIND Field Project Coordinator.

With no further questions and no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 11:20 a.m.
