**Item A. Miami-Dade County Small-Scale Derelict Vessel Removal Project Request,
Miami-Dade County, FL.**

Miami-Dade County has submitted a funding assistance request for the removal of eight (8) derelict vessels located on and adjacent to the Intracoastal Waterway in Miami, FL. The total project cost is estimated to be \$54,800.00. Consistent with Rule 66B-2.015, Small-Scale Derelict Vessel Removal Projects, the request is eligible for up to seventy-five percent (75%) District cost-share funding, to a maximum of \$30,000.00 per county, per year.

Dear Mr. Crosley:

Please find enclosed a completed Small-Scale Derelict Vessel Removal Program Application submitted on behalf of the Miami-Dade County Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources' Division of Environmental Resources Management (DERM). DERM is applying for funding for the removal and disposal of eight (8) derelict vessels located in the District's waterways within Miami-Dade County. All of the vessels were removed from Biscayne Bay in October and November of 2015. The vessels' locations were within approximately 120 yards to 2 miles of the Intracoastal Waterway and all represented hazards to navigation and the environment.

The contracted cost for the removal and disposal of these vessels totaled \$54,800.00. We are requesting that FIND fund approximately 55 percent of these costs (i.e. \$30,000.00). The remaining contracted costs will be paid for by Miami-Dade County's Biscayne Bay Environmental Enhancement Trust Fund. Please note that the contracted costs are based on the lowest bids received from pre-qualified vendors via a competitive bidding process. Additionally, all costs related to management and oversight of the project were born by Miami-Dade County and are not included in the \$54,800.00 contracted cost.

In addition to the required Attachments A and B of the application, enclosed are FWC derelict vessel database reports for each of the eight derelict vessels, photographs of the derelict vessels before and during removal, aerial photo maps showing the vessels' locations, and contractor invoices. We respectfully request that this application be considered at the next scheduled meeting of the FIND Commission.
