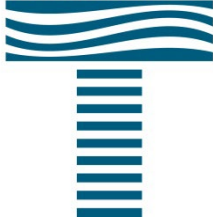

**SUMMARY OF QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES**

1. **QUESTION:** Are you going to provide the cad files for the job?

**RESPONSE:** CAD files will not be provided.

2. **QUESTION:** Do you have an estimated price for the job?

**RESPONSE:** The estimated price is between \$1,000,000 and \$3,000,000

3. **QUESTION:** Please confirm that contractor will be paid on actual quantities for bid items not listed as lump sum on the last revetment project all items were lump sum.

**RESPONSE:** The bedding and armor stone quantities listed in the bid documents are actual quantities required per the design. Contractor shall provide a bid based on the quantities presented in the bid documents.

4. **QUESTION:** Is builder's risk insurance at 100% contract value required since it will provide no coverage?

**RESPONSE:** Risk Insurance should be provided as specified.

5. **QUESTION:** Is a FDOT Right of Way permit & bond required for the existing entry turnout from US1?

**RESPONSE:** Per Section 00 72 00 and 01 35 43 it is the Contractor's responsibility to obtain all relevant Federal, State, and local permits at no cost to the Owner. The Contractor must determine applicable permits required.

6. **QUESTION:** There is not a problem providing a bid cost for the gopher tortoise survey, but providing a cost to relocate the found gopher tortoises is impossible until you complete the survey. Gopher tortoise relocations are very expensive and based on each gopher tortoise. Will the engineer please add a line item to the bid form to relocate each gopher tortoise using a contingency amount of ten gopher tortoises? Example below;

**RESPONSE:** The bid schedule has been revised to include gopher tortoise relocation. The revised bid schedule is attached.

7. **QUESTION:** If we find a customer, are we allowed to sell and haul off site any excess excavation?

**RESPONSE:** No. Any excess excavation material shall be placed in the borrow/disposal area identified on the project drawings.

8. **QUESTION:** Is Bid Item 11 Install & Establish Sod actually for the sea oats plantings?

**RESPONSE:** Correct

9. **QUESTION:** Is there any fresh water on site for haul road and plantings watering?

**RESPONSE:** No freshwater is available at the SJ-1 site. Freshwater may be available from nearby surface sources beyond FIND property. Contractor is responsible for obtaining the necessary permissions.

10. **QUESTION:** May we burn on site since the area is so remote?

**RESPONSE:** No. All cleared vegetation must be removed from the site and disposed of appropriately.

11. **QUESTION:** Is any type of dewatering permit required for the project?

**RESPONSE:** Per Section 00 72 00 and 01 35 43 it is the Contractor's responsibility to obtain all relevant Federal, State, and local permits at no cost to the Owner. The Contractor must determine applicable permits for proposed construction methods.

12. **QUESTION:** Has the entry road (+/-3 miles) been improved since the last revetment project due to the soft sands causing many trucks to get stuck in the road without constant grading and/or watering?

**RESPONSE:** The use and maintenance of the entry road is beyond FIND's control and is often used by others. Contractor to evaluate the road based on conditions observed during the site visit.

13. **QUESTION:** I am reaching out in regards to the project listed above. The Sea Oat plants specs. state "All plant materials shall be grown in multi-well trays (liners) not to exceed 1.5 inches wide by 1.5 inches long and not less than 2.5 inches in depth." Our tray liners are measured at 1.57 inches x 1.57 inches (top of each cell) with a 1.97 inch depth.

Will this size substitution be allowed?

**RESPONSE:** The tray liner size is acceptable. Note that all other requirements of Section 32 92 16, including survival, must be met.

The Contractor shall include in the Bid, any item for which a separate pay item has not been established in the Bid Form (under any related pay item), to reflect the total price for completing the project in its entirety.
4	Quantities shown are estimated. Actual quantity may vary due to estimated excavation or fill.
5	Contractor shall meet requirements of all applicable permits and codes (in their current edition).
