

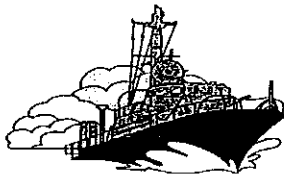

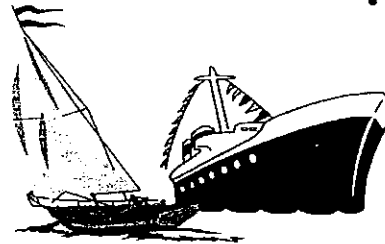

NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS

OKEECHOBEE WATERWAY, FLORIDA

1. Mariners are advised that Route 2 is and has been open since 9 February 2009. Conditions of Route 2 are as follows:

a. Route 2: Based on the 2008 Channel Condition Survey, the minimum depth of Route 2 at a Lake elevation of 13.98 feet-NGVD is 5.32 ft.

*Note: Adjusted depth is already reduced by two feet due to shoaling in Route 2. See link below for access to recent Survey information and updated Notice to Navigation Reports.

b. Mariners are advised that if they transit Route 2, to take precautions according to prevailing weather; adhere to Route 2 marked channel, avoiding uncharted waters; and be aware that depths could drop at any time.
