- Plastic bags\*
- Styrofoam
- Household trash
- Medical waste
- Mixed metal or wires
- No tanglers (cords, hoses, wires, etc.)
- Food waste
- Broken glass
- Window or mirror glass
- Dishes or cookware
- Aluminum foil or trays
- Light bulbs
- Clothing or fabric
- Hardcover books
- Yard waste
- Shredded paper
- Hazardous waste
- Liquid waste (paint, cleaners, etc.)

- ⊗ Clothing or textiles\*\*

- ⊗ Disposable cups  
(plastic and coffee)
- ⊗ Electronics\*\*
- ⊗ Food-tainted items
- ⊗ Hazardous waste
- ⊗ Household glass
- ⊗ Medical waste
- ⊗ Plastic bags/wrap\*
- ⊗ Scrap metal/wood\*\*
- ⊗ Shredded paper\*\*
- ⊗ Styrofoam/peanuts
- ⊗ Tangles  
(cords, hoses, wires, etc.)
- ⊗ Tires\*\*
- ⊗ Toys
