

**NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF BOND RESOLUTION  
SUBJECT TO PERMISSIVE REFERENDUM  
AUTHORIZING A LIGHTING CAPITAL  
IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT WITHIN THE TOWN**

Notice is hereby given that at its July 6, 2020 meeting the Town Board of the Town of Grand Island adopted a bond resolution authorizing a lighting capital improvements project within the Town, such project to generally consist of, but not be limited to, the acquisition of approximately 240 streetlights from National Grid and the replacement of high pressure sodium luminaries with LED luminaries, including all preliminary work and necessary equipment, materials and related site work and all preliminary costs and other improvements and costs incidental thereto and in connection with the financing thereof, as more fully identified in (or contemplated by) a report prepared by the Town Engineering Department (collectively, the "Purpose") at an estimated maximum cost of \$600,000. Such resolution authorizes the issuance and sale of a serial bond or bonds and a bond anticipation note or notes in anticipation of the issuance and sale of such serial bonds, in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$600,000 of the Town, such amount to be offset by any federal, state, county and/or local funds received. Such resolution is subject to permissive referendum pursuant to New York law.
