## Statement of Election Results

May 24, 2005

The following is a statement of the results of an election held in the Borough of Haddonfield, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, on the 10<sup>th</sup> of May in 2005 for the purpose of electing three Commissioners for said Borough, in accordance with Section 40:70-1 to 40:76-27 inclusive of the Revised Statutes of New Jersey of the year 1937 as amended and supplemented.

The total number of ballots cast is 4,330 (includes Absentee Ballots)

The total number of registered voters is 8,755


The number of ballots cast for the several candidates is as follows:
