Position: Full Time EMT/Station Attendant

Salary Range: As of 11/01/22- Starts at \$1,097.52 per week. Moves in 7 equal annual steps annually to a maximum of \$1343.43 per week.

Benefits: Medical, dental & prescription coverage with an employee contribution. State pension and contributory life insurance, with payroll deductions, is required. Paid time off provided based on years of service.

Work Schedule: Forty (40) hours per week, including nights and weekends. Shift to be adjusted at managements discretion based on the needs of the department. Additional hours may be required and will be paid overtime at time plus one-half.

Work Location: Fire Station, 15 N Haddon Ave Haddonfield, NJ 08033

Reports to: Chief of Fire Department

Principle Responsibilities:

The EMT/Station Attendant is primarily responsible for responding to all EMS calls as dispatched, rendering proper emergency medical treatment as appropriate, and transferring the patient to a medical center or hospital for proper care. This position involves working with other personnel that are assigned to the department by the Borough of Haddonfield, as well as the volunteer members of Haddon Fire Company No. 1 and the Haddonfield Ambulance Association.

Additional Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Maintaining the readiness and cleanliness of the fire station building and grounds as well as ensuring building and equipment safety and security.
- Preparation and submission of the Daily Shift Report to management, with attached copies of all incident reports.
- Participation in EMS and other emergency training, including completion of continuing education requirements.
- Completion of public education and public relation duties as assigned.
- Completion of special assignments and duties assigned by the Chief of the Department.

Requirements:

- High School Diploma
- New Jersey Certified EMT or NREMT
- CPR: BLS Healthcare Provider Certification
- Satisfactory Motor Vehicle driving record and valid NJ Drivers License.
- Satisfactory physical condition, with demonstrated ability to deploy emergency equipment, as well as manipulated, lift and transfer of patients.
- Satisfactory medical and psychological evaluation performed by a borough designated license professional.

Qualifications:

- Problem solving and emergency management skills
- Communication skills-verbal and written
- Ability to work with others as a team
- Public relations skills
- Ability to coordinate and interact well with department management and fellow employees on a daily basis
- Must be able to learn new skills and procedures without problems.
- Must be flexible and be able to change with the needs of the Borough.
- **Must be service oriented.**
