Dear Resident,

Please be advised that on Friday April 27, 2018 at or around 9:00 a.m., the water system will be shut down to repair several Fire Hydrants and replacement of water main valves. It is anticipated the water will off for approximately 6 hours. This will affect all homes on Ethel street from Weber to Burson and possibly some homes on Burson and Weber.

Since the water pressure will be taken down to zero pressure, a precautionary boil water advisory is issued for 72 hours or until noticed. **A precautionary boil water advisory is intended for any water that will be used for human consumption.**

We apologize for any inconvenience that this may cause. This repair to the water system a planned event to replace old worn out valves and hydrants.
