Re: Water Main Break and Precautionary Boil Water Advisory

Dear Resident,

Please be advised that on Sunday January 27, 2019 at or around 11:20 a.m., the water system received a call that there was water observed at or near a water main. The operator dispatched a crew and mobilized our contractor for an emergency repair. It was determined that the complete water system for the entire **Country Club Subdivision** in **Brighton Township** will be shut down for approximately 2 hours to make repairs. This is an emergency repair most likely due to the recent cold temperatures.

Since the water pressure will be taken down to zero pressure, a precautionary boil water advisory is issued for 72 hours or until noticed. **A precautionary boil water advisory is intended for any water that will be used for human consumption.**

We apologize for any inconvenience that this may cause. This repair to the water system a planned event to replace old worn out valves and hydrants.
