## Final year of the Hometown Heroes program

Applications for the Hometown Heroes Program will be accepted from the first of November until the 31<sup>st</sup>; the entire month of November.

Similar to last year's project, the program will Highlight the military service of past or present Hartland residents.

Hometown Heroes banners featuring the photograph and name of military service personnel as well as their rank and branch of service will be displayed on power poles on Route 104 between Hartland Corners and Johnson Creek. Banners may be purchased by family or friends who wish to honor their hometown heroes.

The cost is \$185 per banner. Applicants will receive two free booklets containing the photographs and synopsis of service members in this year's project. Also, all soldiers in the Hometown Heroes program will be included in the history book that will be published next year.
