## Example of service member's military history

Brett enlisted in the United States Army on May 7<sup>th</sup>. 1967 and served during the Vietnam Era. After completing basic training at Fort Dix New Jersey he attended advanced schooling at Redstone Arsenal Alabama where he learned the skills needed to install equipment and troubleshoot problems in the Pershing missile system.

In September 1967 he received orders to report to Fort Sill Oklahoma where he was assigned to the 41<sup>st</sup> Artillery Regiment. His missile unit was deployed to Schwabisch Germany. While there Brett attained the rank of Spec 5.

Upon completion of his tour in Germany he was assigned to the 5<sup>th</sup> Battalion 7<sup>th</sup> Artillery, a missile contingent at Fort Bliss Texas. Brett served the remainder of his military service at this post and was discharged from the army on May 4<sup>th</sup> 1970.
