



## Town of Hartland Recycling & Refuse Guidelines



Beginning January 2017, all households in the Town will have their garbage and recycling services provided by Modern Disposal Services. Thursday will be the new collection day with the first collection taking place on January 6th (Friday) due to the Monday holiday.

Garbage in trash carts only will be collected every Thursday and recycling will be collected on alternating Thursdays. The Town will offer "Bag Tags" if you have additional bags of trash which don't fit in the trash cart. The cost per tag will be \$3.50 each for bags no larger than 30-gallon size. Please refer to the map provided to see which week your recycling will be collected. Red streets will be collected on the "A" week and Blue streets collected on the "B" week.

New in 2017, we will begin the use of trash carts. Trash carts must be placed within 5 feet of the roadside by 6:30 a.m. on Thursday. Please refer to the calendar to see which holidays will cause a delay in service.

Bulk items, such as yard waste and other bulky materials like furniture and appliances, will be collected the first full week of every month. The maximum allowed each bulk collection cycle is two (2) items. They can be any combination of appliances, furniture, bundle of yard waste, or properly contained C & D waste. These items will be collected separately from your household waste and/ or recycling. Please follow these simple guidelines:

- **Yard waste must be bagged or containerized and must not weigh in excess of 55 pounds; or it may be bundled and tied in 4-foot lengths or less and no more than 4 inches in diameter.**
- **Plasterboard, scrap wood, etc. must also be less than 4 feet in length, not exceed 55 pounds and must be bundled or containerized**
- **Carpeting must be rolled in 4-foot or less lengths and taped securely. Rolls should not exceed 55 pounds.**
- **Bulk items such as chairs and couches should be placed at the curb.**
- **Tires will not be accepted.**
- **Christmas trees will only be collected during or after holiday season and will count as your bulk item for that week.**
- **No contractor materials will be collected.**

Please refer to the recycling guidelines located on the top of your recycling cart and within this publication. If in doubt, feel free to call Modern Disposal Services customer service department at 800-330-7107. Recycling does not need to be separated. It will continue to be collected as a single stream and sorted mechanically at Modern's facility. Please be sure all cardboard is no bigger than 2' x 2', and place it next to your recycling container. Recycling must be placed in the blue, Town-provided recycling container.

Electronic Waste was banned from curbside collection in 2012 by NYSDEC. This includes items such as computers, televisions and radios. Electronic waste will not be collected by Modern Disposal, but Town residents may take e-waste to the Town Highway Department on the 4th Tuesday of each month from June through January between the hours of 8 a.m. and 3 p.m.
