CHAPTER 72: TRAFFIC SCHEDULES

SCHEDULE I. THROUGH STREETS AND STOP INTERSECTIONS.

- (A) Declaration. Those streets, parts of streets and stop intersections described in this schedule are hereby declared to be through streets or stop intersections for the purpose of this schedule. When signs are erected giving notice thereof, drivers of vehicles shall stop at every intersection before entering any of the described streets or parts of streets in any provision of this schedule. (Prior Code, § 10.20.010)
- (B) Signs. Every sign erected pursuant to this schedule shall bear the word stop in letters at least 8 inches high, shall be luminous or illuminated at night and located as near as practicable to the intersection.

(C) Regulation. When stop signs are erected at intersections as herein provided, every driver of a vehicle shall stop the vehicle at the sign before entering the intersection unless directed to proceed by a police officer or traffic control signal.

(D) Schedule. Except as herein otherwise expressly provided, all streets running north and south shall be designated as preferential or through streets and driver of vehicles shall stop at every intersection before entering any of the north and south streets and traffic on east and west streets shall stop for north and south streets.

SCHEDULE II. USE OF MOTORIZED AND NON-MOTORIZED VEHICLES.

The use of rollerskates, inline skates, skateboards, bicycles, motorbikes, motorcycles, motorscooters and similar vehicles or devices shall be prohibited on the sidewalks along Main Street from Adams Street to Franklin Street and along the sidewalks and the raised part of the Town Square from Washington Street north to Main Street to Brown Street.

SCHEDULE III. ALLEY TRAFFIC.

- (A) It shall be unlawful for any person operating or driving a motor vehicle, motor bicycle or other vehicle, upon any and all of the public alleys in the town, to park the motor vehicle, motor bicycle or other vehicle in or upon the right-of-way of any public alley, in a manner so as to block ingress or egress to private property, or in a manner so as to inhibit, encumber or block the throughway of any alley. (Prior Code, Ch. 8.30, § I)
- (B) It shall not be considered a violation of this schedule for motor vehicles, motor bicycles or other vehicles to park in public alleys or portions thereof that shall have been heretofore or shall hereafter be designated by the proper authorities as loading zones, so long as any such vehicle is actually engaged in loading or unloading from any such designated zone.

- (C) The police authorities of the town may order any motor vehicle, motor bicycle or other vehicle parked in violation of this division, towed away and the owner of any such vehicle shall pay all tow charges incidental thereto.

SCHEDULE IV. ONE-WAY STREETS AND ALLEYS.

Upon the following streets and parts of streets and alleys hereinafter described, vehicular traffic shall move only in the indicated direction when proper signs indicating the direction of traffic are erected and maintained at every intersection where movement in the opposite direction is prohibited. (Prior Code, § 10.16.010)

(A) North bound traffic only. The following streets are hereby declared to be north bound traffic only:

- (D) Preferential streets and stop intersections.
- (1) Except as herein otherwise expressly provided, all streets running north and south shall be designated as preferential streets or through streets and drivers of vehicles shall stop at every intersection before entering any of the north and south streets and traffic on east and west streets shall stop for north and south streets.
- (2) Cross walk in the 300 block on North Adams Street, vehicular traffic on North Adams Street shall stop for pedestrians using the cross walk at such times and during the hours when the electric red flasher signal located at the cross walk shall be flashing. (Ord. 5-59, passed 1-4-1959)
- (3) The following streets and stop intersections are hereby declared to be preferential streets or stop intersections, when proper signs giving notice thereof are erected:

SCHEDULE V. SPEED REGULATIONS.

- (A) (1) The speed laws and regulations of the state, shall apply on all streets and highways of the town and are hereby adopted by reference and made a part of this schedule as fully as if the same were attached hereto and incorporated herein, and is on file for public inspection in the office of the Clerk-Treasurer during normal business hours of operation.

- (2) It is hereby determined and declared that a reasonable and safe prima facie speed limit not to exceed 20 mph at the following street intersections:
- (a) All streets intersecting Washington Street from Brown Street to Morgan Street, inclusive; and
- (b) All streets intersecting Adams Street from Brown Street to Morgan Street, inclusive. (Prior Code, § 10.12.020)
- (3) Appropriate signs shall be placed upon the approaches to the street intersections described in division (A)(2) above showing a speed limit of 20 mph. (Prior Code, § 10.12.030) (Ord. 421, passed 10-18-1948)
- (B) It shall be unlawful for any conductor, engineer or other person, having the care, management and running of any railway locomotive or train of cars, to run the same at a speed greater than 12 mph through the corporate limits of the town.
