

CHAPTER 91: PARKS AND RECREATION

§ 91.01 SUPERVISION, MANAGEMENT AND CONTROL.

The supervision, management and control of the parks of Knightstown is hereby vested in the Parks and Recreation Board, as provided in Chapter 32 of this code.

§ 91.02 SPONSORING OR CONDUCTING PROJECTS.

The Parks and Recreation Board shall have full authority to require individuals and/or organizations sponsoring or conducting projects in the parks to submit a general course of operation to the Board for its approval and the individual or organization shall be bound by the ruling of the Board, subject only to appeal from the ruling of Board to the Town Council.

§ 91.03 CUTTING TREES WITHOUT AUTHORIZATION PROHIBITED.

No individual or organization shall in any way cut trees, make improvements or any changes in the parks without first having obtained the approval from the Park and Recreation Board to do so.

§ 91.04 REGULATING VEHICULAR TRAFFIC.

Sunset Park in the town is closed to vehicular traffic during the hours of 11:00 p.m., through and including 8:00 a.m. daily, and there shall be no vehicular traffic in Sunset Park during the above referred hours, except as follows.

(A) Any special events approved by the Town Council and/or the Police Department allowing vehicular traffic during the above referred to hours shall be permissible.

(B) This chapter is not intended to limit pedestrian traffic during the above named hours, but only vehicular traffic. It is the intention of this chapter to limit the use of automobiles in the Sunset Park during the above enumerated hours and no other purpose.
