

ORDINANCE NO. 4-2003  
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 10,  
CHAPTER 10.28, PARKING REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, the Town of Knightstown Code of Ordinances, Title 10, Chapter 10.28 provides for parking regulations in the Town of Knightstown; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council believes it is desirable to provide for additional regulation of parking on the Town Square.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDAINED by the Town Council of Knightstown, Indiana as follows:

1. The Town of Knightstown Code of Ordinances, Title 10, Chapter 10.28 is hereby amended by adding 10.28.010 (H) to read as follows:
  - A. When appropriate signs are in place, no person shall park a vehicle between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 4:00 a.m. in the absence of a valid parking permit on the Town Square.
  - B. When appropriate warning signs are in place, the vehicles of violators shall be towed at the owner's expense.
  - C. A valid permit allowing parking on the Town Square between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 4:00 a.m. may be obtained from the Town Clerk-Treasurer but only for those persons who live or work in the area during the prohibited parking times. The cost of a parking permit shall be ten dollars (\$10.00), which shall be refunded when the permit is returned to the Town Clerk-Treasurer. The permit must be displayed on the rearview mirror of any vehicle parking in the restricted area.
  - D. The above restrictions shall not apply to special events and activities on the Town Square which are sanctioned by the Town Council of Knightstown.

2. The Knightstown Code of Ordinances Title 10 Chapter 10.28 is hereby further amended by adding the following additional paragraph to 10.28.020, penalty:

Violators of Section 10.28.010(H) shall be punished by a fine of seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) and each day of violation shall be considered a distinct and separate offense.

3. To the extent that this ordinance is inconsistent with any previously adopted ordinances, the provisions of this ordinance shall control.

4. This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days following publication of notice of its passage by the Town Council.

5. Violation of this ordinance shall result in a penalty of seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) per violation and shall be enforced by the Ordinance Violations Bureau upon the terms and conditions set forth at Ordinance No. 3-1990, adopted by the Town Council of Knightstown, Indiana.
