

SSIS with Crystal Reports

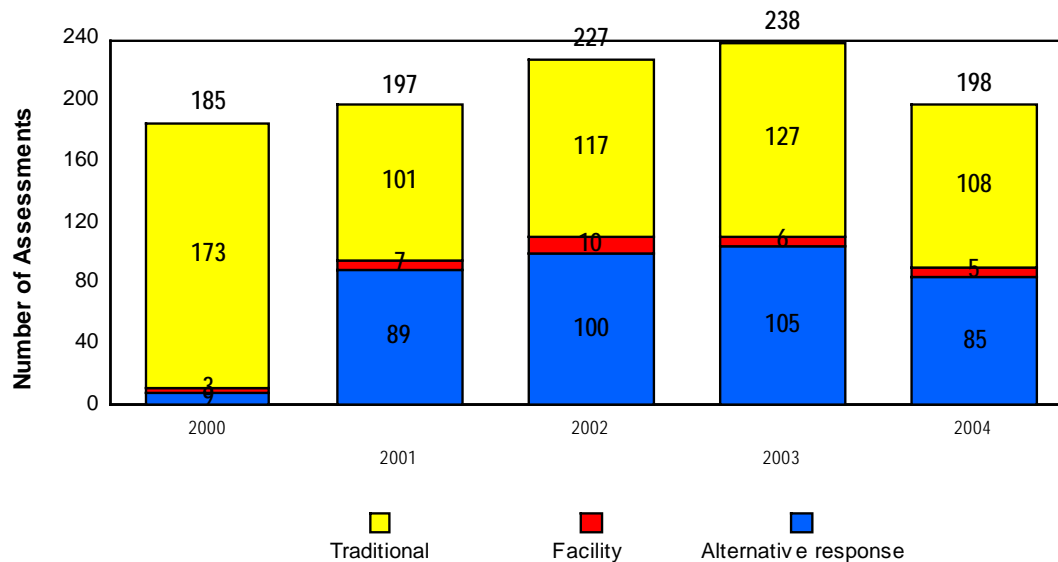


Crystal Reports Software

- Is a report writing tool for database tables.
- Connects to SSIS tables through an ODBC driver.
- Can link SSIS tables to create just about any report you can imagine.
- Because each county has the same SSIS table structure, Crystal Reports SSIS templates can easily be shared between counties.

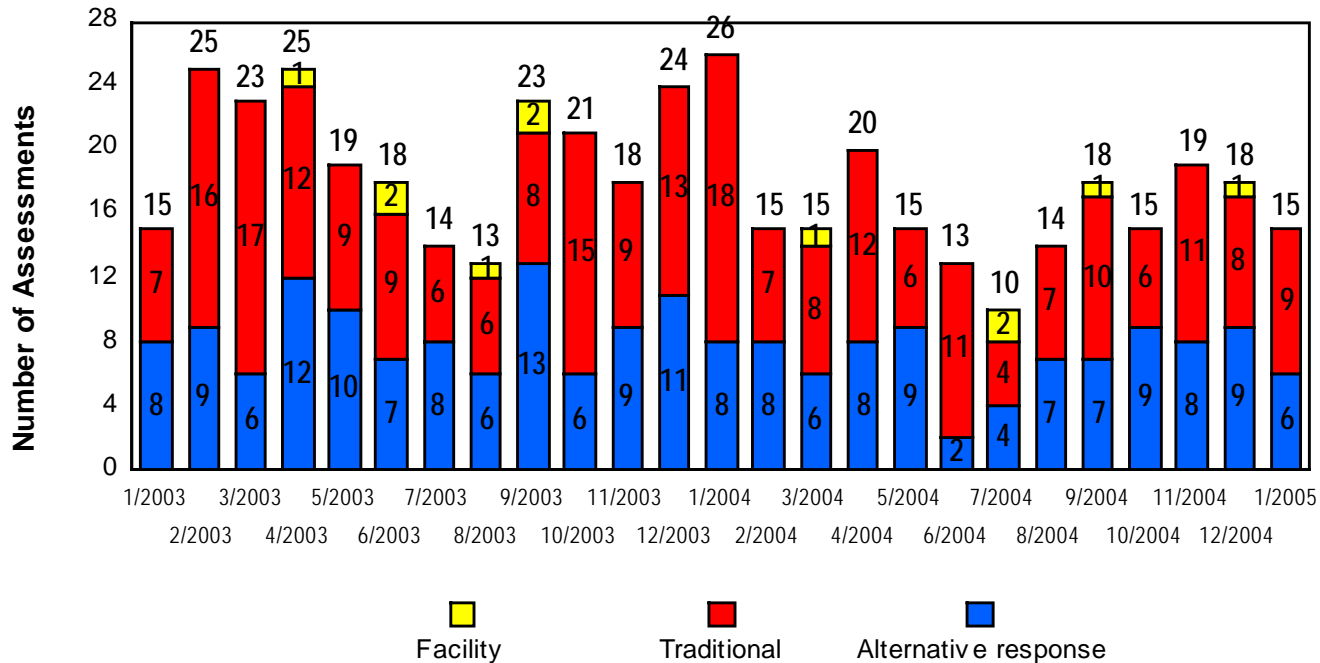

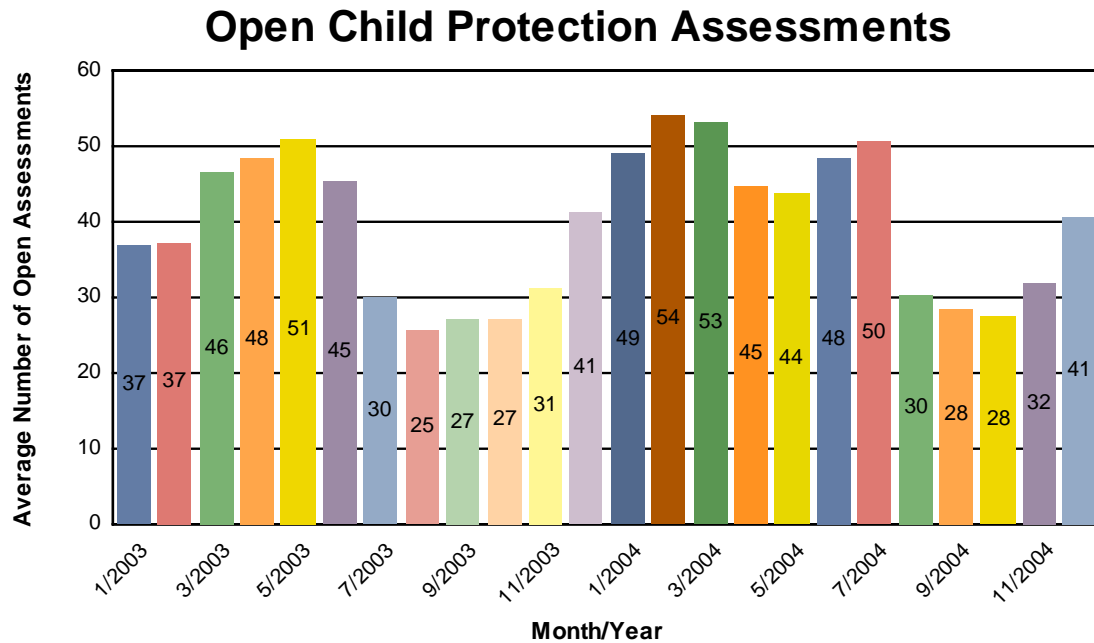

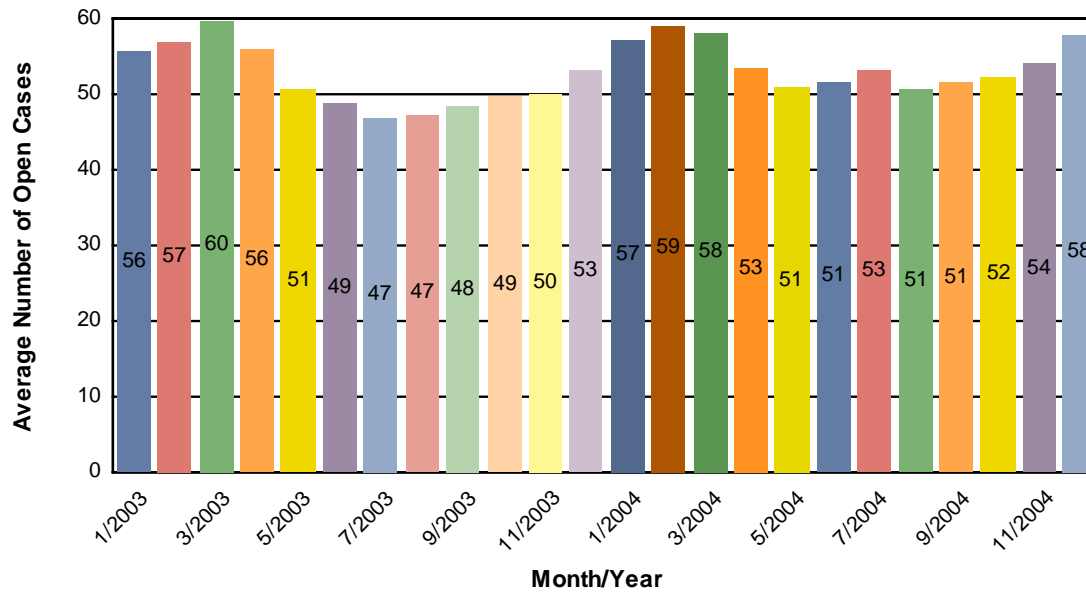

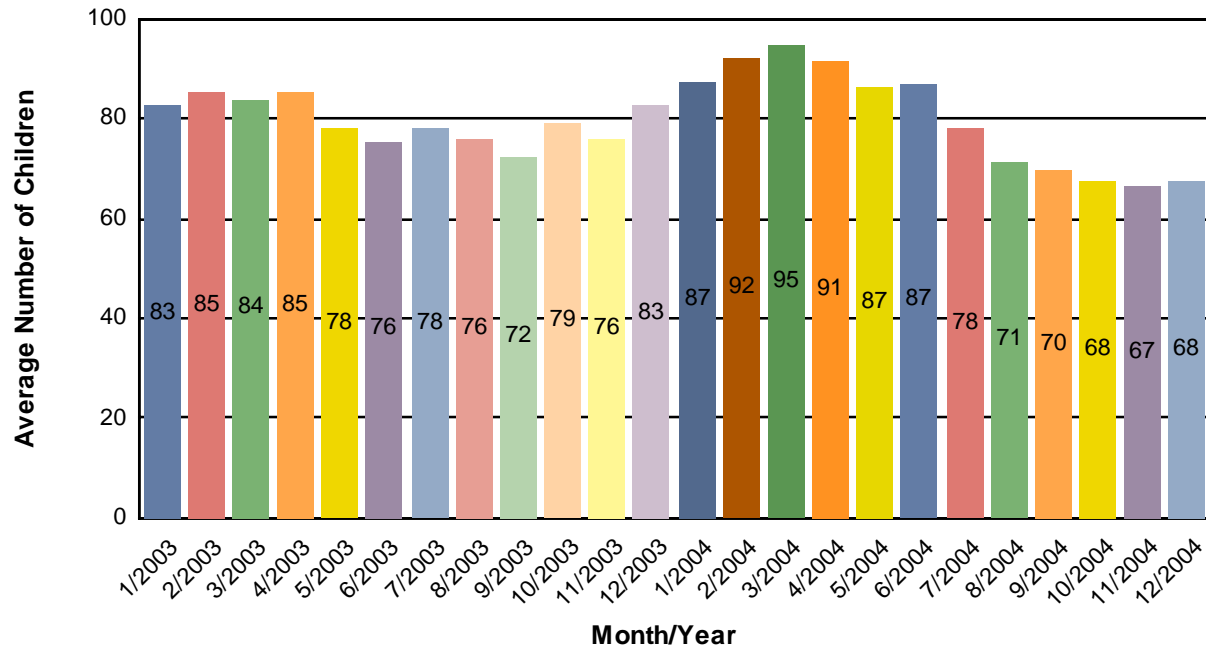
