## Taxiway "C" Project

J&J Contractors continued to work on the taxiway "C" project. This has included work on the new stub taxiway between taxiway "A" and runway 17/35, the extended dry detention basins adjacent to the runway 17 approach areas and on the new section of taxiway east of runway 17/35. Construction was suspended on December 30<sup>th</sup> and is scheduled to resume on April 1<sup>st</sup> 2023. Engineering consultant DuBois & King and the airport manager continued work closely with the contractor.

## **Monthly Revenues**

For the months of November and December two deposits were posted to the Treasurer's office. This totaled \$51,287.86 in payments.

## **Monthly Fuel Flowage**

For the months of November and December, *Flight Level's* bills of lading for fuel totaled 74,333 gallons. At \$.07/gallon, the Town received \$5,203.31 in flowage fees.

For the months of November and December, *Boston Executive Helicopter's* bills of lading for fuel totaled 20,203 gallons. At \$.07/gallon, the Town received \$1,414.21 in flowage fees.

## Assistant Airport Manager

Candidates for the position of Assistant Airport Manager were interviewed in late November by the human resources department and the airport manager. An offer of employment was made to Mr. Jesse Coreas who accepted the position. His first day of employment with the town was January 3<sup>rd</sup> 2023.
