

**Minutes**

Present: Chairman Thomas Maloney, Selectman Helen Abdallah Donohue, Selectman Matt Lane, Selectman Allan Howard, Selectmen William Plasko, Town Manager Tony Mazzucco, Executive Assistant Jess Jozwik.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm by Chairman Maloney, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silent prayer or reflection.

Chairman Maloney requested that the Board begin with new business.

On motion of Selectman Donohue, seconded by Selectman Howard, the Board voted unanimously to approve the placement of a banner on the poles on Washington Street between Vernon and Day Streets from Monday, April 25<sup>th</sup> to May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2022 – advertising Household Hazardous Waste/Recycling Day.

On motion of Selectman Donohue, seconded by Selectman Howard, the Board voted unanimously to approve an Easter Egg Hunt Fundraiser on Saturday, April 16<sup>th</sup>, 2022 from 11 AM until 3 PM at Disabled Veterans Park on Chapel and Berwick Streets. Selectman Howard made certain to mention the importance of Leave No Trace and the expectation that the park remain in good condition and is left clean at the end of this event.

On motion of Selectman Howard, seconded by Selectman Lane, the Board voted unanimously to approve a local performance of Flying High Dogs on the morning of Tuesday, July 12<sup>th</sup>, 2022 in the Bond Street Park. Selectman Donohue stated that she hopes the Library will now allow the Girl Scouts to sell cookies in the Library parking lot now that the Board is allowing the Library to use the Bond Street Lot.

On motion of Selectman Plasko, seconded by Selectman Howard, the Board voted unanimously to approve the placement of a geocaching box in Shattuck Park.

Application has been made for a Retail Wine and Malt Beverages License to be drunk on the premises for Oasis Caribbean Cuisine, dba Oasis Caribbean Cuisine, Manager of Record, Ercy Olivier located at 487 Washington Street. The Board requested that the application be completed and they be presented with all materials. On motion of Selectman Plasko, seconded by Selectman Lane, the Board voted unanimously to continue this meeting until March 29<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

Application has been made for a Retail Wine and Malt Beverages License to be drunk on the premises for Luke Adams, Inc., Manager of Record, Luke Adams, located at 83 Morse Street, Building 2. On motion of Selectman Donohue, seconded by Selectman Lane, the Board voted unanimously to approve this application.

Application has been made for All Alcoholic Beverages to be drunk on the premises for S & H Westbury Farms, Inc. dba 1947 Norwood, located at 997 Boston Providence Highway. Four community members appeared to speak in favor of 1947 being granted a Liquor License. On motion of Selectman Plasko, seconded by Selectman Lane, the Board voted unanimously to approve under the condition that the Board receives a copy of 1947's Worker's Comp information.

Boch Luxe M, Inc. dba Boch Maserati, Ernest Boch Jr., Manager of Record, for change of location from 441 Boston Providence Highway to 386 Neponset Street. The business will remain the same. On motion of Selectman Donohue, seconded by Selectman Howard, the Board voted unanimously to approve the change of location from 441 Boston Providence Highway to 386 Neponset Street.

Farah and Sons, Manager of Record, Marie Momgiane applying for a new Class II Auto Dealer's License to be used at 417 Nahatan Street for the sale of used vehicles. On motion of Selectman Lane seconded by Selectman Howard the Board voted 4-1 in favor of approving the Class II Auto Dealer's License to be used at 417 Nahatan Street.

Application has been made for Pouring Permit for Irish Brewing Boston, Inc. dba Irish Brewing, Manager of Record, Carl Sharpley on the premises of 83 Morse Street, Building 4. On motion of Selectman Lane, seconded by Selectman Donohue, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Pouring Permit for Irish Brewing Boston, Inc.

Inter-municipal Agreement with South Eastern Regional Emergency Communications Center. Selectman Plasko recused himself from discussion on this matter. On the motion of Selectman Howard, seconded by Selectman Lane the Board voted 3-1 in favor of entering an inter-municipal agreement with the South Eastern Regional Emergency Communications Center.

Submitting request to hold a car wash to support the Swim Team on June 18<sup>th</sup>, 2022 and another to support the Dive Team on August 27<sup>th</sup>. On the motion of Selectman Howard, seconded by Selectman Lane the Board voted unanimously to approve the request of a car wash permit on the aforementioned dates.

Submitting request for a One Day Liquor License – Wine and Malt Beverages only on Saturday, March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2022 for a pre-wedding brunch at 884 Washington Street from 1 PM until 4 PM. On the motion of Selectman Howard, seconded by Selectman Lane the Board voted unanimously to approve the One Day Liquor License to Perry's Catering, Inc.

Submitting request to use the Town Common for a community picnic and fair on Sunday, April 24<sup>th</sup>, 2022 from 11:30 AM until 2:00 PM. Approximately 300 attendees expected as

well as 15 – 20 groups at tables with information related to sustainability and Earth Day. On the motion of Selectman Donohue, seconded by Selectman Howard, the Board voted unanimously to approve the use of the common for the Earth Day festivities.

Submitting request for use of the Town Common/Gazebo for a wedding ceremony on July 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2022 from 2:00 PM until 4:30 PM. 60 -70 attendees expected. On the motion of Selectman Lane, seconded by Selectman Howard, the Board voted unanimously to approve the use of the Town Common/Gazebo for the purposes of a wedding on July 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2022.

Delia Bartucca, submitting with regret, her resignation from the position as Board Secretary, Norwood Council on Aging – effective immediately. Selectman Donohue moved to send Ms. Bartucca a letter of thanks for her years of service to the town of Norwood. On the motion of Selectman Howard, seconded by Selectman Donohue, the Board voted unanimously to accept Ms. Bartucca’s resignation as well as send her a letter of thanks.

Submitting request to appoint Betty Mastandrea to the Norwood Council on Aging. On the motion of Selectman Donohue, seconded by Selectman Plasko, the Board voted unanimously to approve the appointment of Betty Mastandrea to the Norwood Council on Aging.

Submitting request to appoint Peter McFarland to the Commission on Disability. On the motion of Selectman Donohue, seconded by Selectman Lane, the board voted unanimously to approve the appointment of Peter McFarland to the Commission on Disability.

Submitting request to reappoint James F. Grover to the Norwood Board of Assessors when his current term expires on April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022. On the motion of Selectman Donohue, seconded by Selectman Howard, the Board voted unanimously to approve James F. Grover’s reappointment to the Norwood Board of Assessors.

Submitting monthly report of the Building Department for January 2022. On the motion of Selectman Lane, seconded by Selectman Donohue, the Board voted unanimously to file the proposed information.

Submitting PEG Grant Report – Fourth Quarter/2021. On the motion of Selectman Plasko, seconded by Selectman Donohue, the Board voted unanimously to file the proposed information.
