

TIPS Training

TO: ALL ALCOHOL LICENSEE STAFF

REGISTRATION LIMIT OF 5 PEOPLE PER BUSINESS

The towns of *Dedham, Needham, Norwood, and Westwood* are working together to prevent underage alcohol use across our region as well as to promote road safety. Our Leadership Team, comprised of our towns' Public Health Directors and Chiefs of Police, is offering ***Training and Intervention Procedures for Servers (TIPS) responsible beverage service and sales trainings on Monday, June 3rd in Dedham.***

Our town leaders want servers and sellers to have the skills to: **1)** accurately check identification cards to prevent underage purchases, **2)** identify the visible cues to prevent over-pouring and dangerous over consumption, **3)** identify the stages of impairment and intoxication and employ server intervention procedures for customer safety while maintaining good customer service.

These **FREE 5 hour** trainings, for all staff of **On- Premise (Section 12)** and **Off- Premise (Section 15)** business will be conducted by **TIPS Master Trainer Mike Marcantonio**. At the end of the training session, a three-year **TIPS** certification will be provided to participants who pass a short test. **TIPS** certification may **result in significant cost savings** for many licensees on liability insurance, generally between 10% and 20% depending upon insurer and number of staff trained. www.mass.gov/abcc
