June 26, 2018

Commissioner Dudenhoeffer opened the meeting at 08:30 AM.

Meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of the Agenda: Commissioner Kliethermes motioned to approve the agenda with slight changes. Commissioner Glavin 2nd the motion.
