Approval of the Agenda and Minutes:

-Commissioner Griffin asked for a motion for approval of today's agenda and the meeting minutes for November 15, 2022 and both CLOSED meeting minutes for November 15, 2022. Commissioner Trenshaw made the motion, seconded by Commissioner Kliethermes. Commissioner Griffin asked all in favor say aye. Bills, Notes and Communication:

-It was brought to the attention of the commissioners that the United States flag should be lit if flown throughout the night. Currently the light that is there is not working. Mr. Mike Jacquin, representative of the VA, is a retired electrician and is willing to fix the light if the county pays for the materials.
-Aaron McVicker contacted Commissioner Trenshaw via telephone and would like to do a walk through for county road 303 BRO Bridge Project for the design. Commissioners will be meeting with Jeremy Baysinger today after the meeting.
-There was a request that the Linn Community Betterment Project be able to place snowflakes on the county building windows. Brooke Dudenhoeffer will contact Kelly Frank to coordinate that.
-Commissioner Griffin was contacted again to set up an account to receive the Opioid Settlement amounts. Due to some concerns of the Treasurer, it is advised to ask more questions at the MAC conference next week. All commissioners agree and will hold off on responding.

Health Dept:

-Kim notes that her office is short staffed.
-NO walk-in clinic on Friday November 25, 2022.
-Sallin reports that RSV (respiratory syncytial virus) numbers are extremely high right now. Missouri Children's Hospital is full with pediatric patients. This virus is highly contagious.
-Towner Communications went to the health department building to quote the phone services there.
-Sallin is still waiting for a bid from RCS for installation of the cameras at the building.
-Sallin made the commissioners aware that the health departments trailer is not currently insured. The commissioners recommended that Sallin sell the trailer and the tent on Purple Wave after offering it to Ron Hoffman in 911. This all come about due to the recent theft of the trailer, but now recovered with minimal damage. Commissioner Kliethermes made a motion to sell the trailer on Purple Wave if Ron Hoffman does not need it for the 911/EMA department, seconded by Commissioner Trenshaw. Commissioner Griffin asked all in favor say aye. Commissioner Trenshaw, Commissioner Kliethermes and Commissioner Griffin all stated aye. All opposed, none.
