Sheriffs' Department:

-Commissioner Griffin asked Sheriff Bonham if it is possible to have freedom impaired inmates pick up trash on side of the roads as a community service.
-Sheriff Bonham asked for a signature on a Youth DWI grant. Commissioner Griffin signed the grant.
-Bonham said 2 of the Durango's came in. There had been an issue with the title in which Bonham had that corrected.

911:

-Ron Hoffman came up to have commissioners sign a proclamation for Telecommunicators Week. Commissioner Kliethermes made a motion to sign the telecommunication week proclamation, seconded by Commissioner Trenshaw. Commissioner Griffin asked all in favor say aye. Commissioner Griffin, Commissioner Trenshaw and Commissioner Kliethermes all stated aye. All opposed, none.

Road and Bridge:

-Ron Kempker handed out the road reports for March 30th through April 12
-Kempker reports still doing bridge inspections with MODOT
-Getting to asphalt as fast as possible. Asks public to be patient.
-Commissioner Kliethermes said he got a call from a woman saying Luebbering Hill was rocked and causing flat tires. Kempker said that County Road 508 is on the list to be completed but he will check on that road to make sure it's not a mud pit.

- Carl Hoffman called to compliment Kempker and his crew for a good job done.
- Kempker received Thank You cards from Fatima 6th Grade Ms. Ellingsworth's class to express thanks for all Road and Bridge does for your community.
- Brooke Dudenhoeffer is to send a Thank you letter to Megan Markway for the students and parents for picking up trash along the county roads. Kempker reported hauling off 3-4 loads of trash.
- Purple Wave is very active as of now.

Health Department:

- Kim introduced new nurse Kandiss Hoffman to the commission
- 7 active cases. Wanted to let us know that Johnson and Johnson has been resent back to the makers to do more testing. Osage County did not administer any. A rare blood clot was found in women whom had the Johnson and Johnson vaccine.
- Osage Ambulance contacted Kim to help with vaccination of the home bound residents.
- Environmentalist came out on Thursday for the sewage drainage. Waiting for the actual report. Landowners are very willing to do what needs to be done.

New Business:

Old Business:

- Judge Lampke spoke with Commissioner Griffin, the bid on the sound system, they would contribute 10,000.00 on that project. Total bid was 14,286.30. Commissioner Trenshaw made a motion that Osage County pay the 4,286.30 to get the sound system in the courthouse, seconded by Commissioner Kliethermes. Commissioner Griffin asked all in favor say aye. Commissioner Griffin, Commissioner Trenshaw and Commissioner Kliethermes all stated aye. All opposed, none. Dudenhoeffer to notify Circuit Clerks office about the ruling on sound system.
- Commissioner Griffin attempted to contact Fence-Pro to verify hauling of the existing fence prior to voting. Dudenhoeffer emailed the company due to no answer and no voicemail.
- Kliethermes contacted Amanda about the report that was due by Kevin Case. Amanda contacted Case and has yet to hear anything.
