-Commissioner Griffin received and e-mail from Claudia Cook asking the commission to appoint Lisa Klebba to the library board. -17.4% of Osage county have been fully vaccinated. 23% have initiated vaccine.

-Moderna vaccine is now allowed to be open for 12 hours. Also, now there is about 10 doses per vial. Kim declines that she is getting calls with concerns of the Johnson and Johnson. Most likely due to OCHD not administering that brand.

-Kim asked if there is an environmental ordinance. Kim has had a complaint saying that a property owner is piling junk and unused vehicles on the persons (not the complaints' property) property. Kim verified that there is no ordinance or that could we issue a citation.

-Kim addressed the mask wearing within your work area. As long as you're in your work area, masking is not mandatory but if you're not in your respective area (i.e. halls, bathroom or breakroom) please wear your mask.
