Bills, Notes and Communication:

- Commissioners reviewed and approved bills. Commissioner Griffin asked for a motion to approve paying bills. - Commissioner Griffin had received a "Thank you" card from Osage County Historical Society.
- Commissioner Griffin had a couple complaints about a mobile home on the edge of the county road 423. Commissioners are going to speak to the sheriff's office to see if the mobile home is an immediate hazard to the public or if it required a 48hour removal tag so that the home owner is to remove the mobile home within a certain amount of time.

- Kim reports that "Fridays walk-in clinic served 36 total vaccinations. Monday, we gave 110 booster vaccinations. Twenty percent of Osage county has completed vaccination."
- Current active cases 6. Of those six, 4 are family members. Kim reports one hospitalization and one additional death.
- Health Department is trying to schedule a 4-7p clinic in Chamois. Date is to be determined.
- Trenshaw asked Kim "Are you starting to feel a resistance (referring the COVID vaccine)?" Kim stated "I haven't gotten calls with resistance but the ones who initially wanted the Johnson & Johnson are open to taking the other brands."
- Johnson & Johnson is resumed, Kim has no intentions on getting it in, but also denies having request for it.
- Kliethermes asked Kim "Have you been able to get your supply of routine vaccines?" Kim responded "Yes."
