## Bills, Notes and Communication:

- Patrick Kliethermes requested a quick claim deed near the Holterman Bridge off of county road 608. Patrick noted that there has been some college kids party and leaving behind gobs of trash in and on the banks of the Maries River. Tim Hamburg will be placing steaks on the property line. Patrick has spoken to Amanda Grellner in which she told him to come to the commissioners. Commissioners discussed with Patrick the exact location of where he is wanting to quick claim. Trenshaw made sure that Patrick knows that he has to get the papers drawn up, then after that the commission will approve it by Amanda Grellner. If she approves it, they will vote to sign it.
- Commissioners reviewed the Treatment Court contract, in which a few changes were requested by the commission. Changes will be submitted for approval then they will vote to sign the contract.
- Commissioner Trenshaw made a motion to sign a document in support for the Steamboat Resolutions funding, seconded by Commissioner Kliethermes. Commissioner Griffin asked all in favor say aye. Commissioner Kliethermes, Commissioner Trenshaw and Commissioner Griffin all stated aye. All opposed, none.
- Commissioners reviewed and approved to pay special bills from MOPERM for the amount of \$1,053.00 and the Legends credit card in amount of \$1,643.51. ## Road & Bridge:

- Kempker handed out the road report for the week of May 17-May 23. Kempker noted that the chips on county road 512, 610, 301 and 302 is all completed. Binks' asphalt done on the court house. Left over material from the finished roads will be used on county road 621. Kempker said that county road 512 full completions will take a few weeks.
- Graders are back in routine.
- The bridge on county road 521 is cleaned off completely.
- New employee, Tom Pottebaum, started yesterday and was introduced to the commissioners today.
- Kempker is looking for a road tractor but Trenshaw mentioned to possibly wait due to fuel prices increasing making costs for vehicles decreasing. Griffin said if ARPA funds are being requested to purchase such equipment a bid request would have to be placed.

-A citizen contacted Commissioner Trenshaw with complaints about county road 804. Commissioner Kliethermes asked if county road 621 is on the board as well to check on, Kempker said it was.
