## Bills, Notes and Communication:

-Commissioners reviewed time sheets. Commissioner Kliethermes made a motion to approve time sheets, seconded by Commissioner Trenshaw. Commissioner Griffin asked all in favor say aye. Commissioner Kliethermes, Commissioner Trenshaw and Commissioner Griffin all stated aye. All opposed, none.

## Road and Bridge

-Kempker handed out the road report.  
-Kempker said that whipper 41 needs a few major boom repairs. The whipper is currently in Chamois at Lenneke's being repaired. Repairs are estimated around \$1,000. There is a grader out of service until possibly Tuesday due to a faulty air conditioner.  
-Trenshaw had complaints about the size of gravel that was being put on the road (county road 801 at Pointer Creek). Kempker noted that the rock is 2inch screened creek gravel that had been placed on that road.  
-Kempker heard back from the CART program. The amount awarded this year is \$13,094.25 for rock which is an increase from last year amount \$12,390.00. Commission signed the document in order to accept the funds.  
-Kempker is still waiting for a second bid for a new grader. Kempker would like the bid to have the joy sticks as it is much more user friendly.

## Health Dept:


-Kim Sallin reports 22 active reported COVID cases.  
-Sallin said Kandiss was on a call with the Missouri Immunization collation in which they are wanting to advertise within the county. Sallin hopes to receive magnets with when school age kids would be required to get immunizations and which immunizations to expect at each age.  
-Sallin said the van could be picked up when the commission approves the bill and a check is signed. Excalibur signs will be placing the decal on the van. Sallin said that the ADCAT would provide a decal to be displayed on the new vehicle. The ADCAT program is an organization geared toward preventing the local youth from experimenting with drugs, tobacco (vaping) and alcohol.
