Approval of the Agenda and Minutes:

-Commissioner Griffin asked for a motion for approval of today's agenda and the meeting minutes for September 13, 2022. Commissioner Trenshaw made a motion to approve today's agenda and the previous meeting minutes, seconded by Commissioner Kliethermes. Commissioner Griffin asked all in favor say aye. Commissioner Kliethermes, Commissioner Trenshaw and Commissioner Griffin all stated aye. All opposed, none.

Bills, Notes and Communication:

- Patrick Kliethermes approached the commission providing a copy of a deed from the state back to the county. This matter is in regards to county road 402 in Loose Creek and the want for the county to vacate the small portion of the "for use" road. According to the documents there is a small sliver of land owned by the heirs of the Voss family and they will not and cannot give or abandon someone else's property. Commissioners said Amanda Grellner needs to be involved and they will not do anything without her approval. Patrick Kliethermes was encouraged to contact legal counsel.
- Commissioners reviewed a quote from Rehagen Heating and Cooling for the cold air return between the County Clerk's office, MU Extension and the Treasurers' office. Kennedy has been requested to get an additional quote.

Road and Bridge

- Keith Thompson provided the commissioners with a quote as requested by the commission. Price includes warranty and trade-in. Keith said the quote is good for 30days. Commissioners agree that something has to be done but they need to know where the money can come from. Commissioners discussed their likes and dislikes. Commissioners requested that Kempker get a quote from CAT to be able to be fair.
- Commissioner Griffin asked Kempker what the status was for county road 317 or 315, and the last stand pipe by the Keiholz residence. Kempker said he has the materials ready but has yet to be able to go there and complete the task due to other pressing issues. Commissioners and Kempker would like to see this project done this year.
- Commissioner Trenshaw requested the status of digging of the ditch on county road 422, in which Kempker said it is complete.
- County road 621 slab is being worked on today.

Sheriff:

- Per Sheriff Bonham, as of today the State Highway Patrol will not sell any used vehicles to outside entities due to a scare of vehicle shortages in the upcoming year. Sheriff Bonham said the most current bid, for a new Durango, is \$5,000 more than what he paid previously.
- Commissioner Kliethermes said Wegman is coming to the Jail to do some plumbing work. Bonham said that Wegman was at the Jail yesterday due to a sheet, towel and wash cloth that had been flushed and Wegman retrieved them out of the sewer lines.

Health Dept:

- Sallin brought the requested billers job description. Sallin has one applicant but the applicant can't start until January 1, 2023.
