Sheriff:

-Lots of grants have been applied for and funds coming in soon.
-Jail housing rates will be increasing as the first of the year.
-Bonham said that the Sheriff's Office is putting a local person through the police academy with a signed 3-year contract. If this person were to be terminated, they would have to pay for the cost of the schooling.

Health Dept.

-The Bivalent vaccine is coming soon.
-The van is going to Excalibur today for decals.
-There are a few resumes that have been submitted for the billing position. Sallin stated that both applicants are both experienced in billing. Sallin would like to offer \$15 an hour for this position. The commission would like to privately discuss pay at a later time after they consult with Amanda Grellner.
-Sallin is still working on the food inspection ordinance. She hopes this will generate a little revenue for the county after her staff expenses are covered.
-Sallin will start applying for a security system grant. Sallin needs at least a specific quote to send with it. Commissioner Trenshaw will contact SecureTech to get a quote.
