Approval of the Agenda and Minutes:

Old Business:

- USDA Grant. Presiding Commissioner Darryl Griffin made a motion to contribute \$ 9,000 toward the USDA grant. Second District Kliethermes second the motion, whereas First District Commissioner voted against the motion. Griffin stated that is the amount we would spend on any other county road.

New Business:

Chief Deputy Amber Hamilton brought to attention that a concerned citizen had stopped by the County Clerk's Office. She stated that the bridge on CR 303 has been spray painted, which is nothing new, however the things that are on there now are very upsetting and vulgar. She was wondering what options she had as far as cleaning the bridge herself. Commissioner's agreed that Foreman Ron Kempker from the Road and Bridge Department contact her regarding which chemicals can be used that is safe for the bridge and the environment.

Health Department:

Road and Bridge: Kempker stated everything is running smooth since the weather is warming up and they will hit more county roads as they continue to dry up. Kempker stated that Employee 1 is going to be out on FLMA starting March 29, 2019 until May 10, 2019 and Employee 2 is also going to be out April 16, 2019 to June 16, 2019 due to having surgery. Glavin asked that Kempker check on CR 271 in Morrison. Truck 39 is back in the shop to finish putting the rest of the injectors in.

Sheriff: Mike Bonham stated that he got the grant filled out. Bonham stated they are looking to surplus the 2006 Dodge Durango and replace it with a 1999 Chevy Suburban that was given to them from the Air Force. The Durango has roughly 187,000 miles on it whereas the Suburban only has roughly 72,000 miles on it. The Suburban is coming fully equipped all except for the radios. Commissioners said that Bonham should speak to County Assessor Jerry Baker and see if he would be interested in taking it since the county assessor vehicle is "falling apart." Bonham stated he would speak to Baker and see what his thoughts were on the vehicle. Bonham stated that he spoke with the insurance company and informed them of the new vehicle, it has not been added since the vehicle is not in our possession as of right now. Bonham did state that the escaped inmate from Pettis County has been caught and is now in custody.
