Road and Bridge:

- Foreman Ron Kempker wanted the Commission to sign a 24 years of service card for Howard Laughlin on June 12th, 2019.
- Foreman Ron Kempker stated that he has been spending more time still in the office.
- Commissioner John Glavin told Ron Kempker that the line / box on CR 275 is gone.
- “The state is not satisfied yet for the reimbursement of the funds” Larry Kliethermes stated. Foreman Ron Kempker said he is still working on getting it addressed.

Sheriff:

- The Sheriff’s office had recovered two stolen vehicles and one stolen boat. The Highway Patrol made the arrest.
- The Sheriff’s office had 2 accidents involving hitting deer. One vehicle which had he push bumper on it has little to no damage. The other vehicle without the push bumper has almost \$3,700.00 worth of damage to it. To buy more push bumpers for the vehicles is around \$300.00. Commissioner Darryl Griffin thinks it would be a good idea to invest in more push bumpers.
- The numbers are looking good for all the bookings in the jail.
- Sheriff Michael Bonham spoke to the Highway Patrol Office and has ceased all boat traffic on the Osage River due to flooding.
