New Business:

-Commission received a letter from Holly Kliethermes regarding her son Carson Kliethermes. Carson Kliethermes is a Boy Scout in troop 217, he was to identify an issue within the county and find out how the issues would be resolved. Carson stated he sees an issue with heavy traffic on Hwy 50 & Hwy CC before and after school, and would like to know how or what the commission is doing to address the issue. Commissioner Griffin stated he would send an email letting them know that the County Commission has been in contact with State Reps and that the State is doing a road study. Commission Glavin suggests that Carson be invited to meet with the county commissioners along with state reps to bring his concerns and get the answers he is looking for.

-Commissioner Griffin stated that he attended the Osage Ambulance Board meeting last night. They ambulance district voted that they will no longer be using Osage County 911 and all 911 ambulance calls will be handled through Gasconade County. Gasconade County will be charging Osage Ambulance \$9.00 per call. Commissioner Griffin stated that they are open to meeting at any time.
-Commissioner Glavin stated “I wish they would come to a meeting. We have an issue and it needs to be worked out. I had a disaster Friday night, EMS and fire did will and they got the address right”

Road and Bridge:

-Kempker stated they are still placing rock on CR 512 operator will head out there tomorrow to address the rough rock issue.
-Commission approved for Kempker to move forward with the interview process.

University of Missouri Extension Office:

-Gulick asked if Commission had a chance to look over the draft letter, he gave to them.
